ICRAF's support to ASFCC aims at developing and mainstreaming a coordinated social-forestry policy framework for ASEAN member states (AMS) with a focus on promoting agroforestry development for climate change mitigation and adaptation, and building resilience.

## Activities

- 1 Synthesis and packaging agroforestry knowledge into a guideline for AMS
- 2 Stocktaking and developing an agroforestry strategy for Cambodia
- 3 Contributing to the Knowledge Tree on Social Forestry
- 4 Collaborating in regional and national agroforestry trainings
- 5 Developing a guide for agroforestry practitioners in AMS
- 6 Facilitating Vietnam's national Agroforestry Technical Working Group to mainstream agroforestry in national strategies
- 7 Providing technical support to the revision of Vietnam's Forestry Law
- 8 Organizing events and policy dialogues at regional levels to advance the state of agroforestry in AMS.

## Expected Outputs

- ASEAN-level guidelines on agroforestry development
- Strategy/roadmap for agroforestry development in Cambodia
- Knowledge Tree on Social Forestry
- Agroforestry training
- Agroforestry practitioners guide
- Policy recommendations and proposals on agroforestry development in Vietnam
- Implementing guidelines of proposed revisions to Vietnam's Forestry Law
- Recommendations relevant to agroforestry development in AMS.
